



FunME EVENTS RULES AND REGULATIONS

MUSIC:

There are NO required selections. Directors are encouraged to select a musical program appropriate for their group's level of development.

TIME:

Each performing group is provided a 15 - 20 minute warm-up, followed by 20 minutes of on-stage time. Music selections should total LESS than 20 minutes to provide time for set-up and dismissal. You must arrive BEFORE your warm-up time to unload coaches and move into the performance building. If you miss your scheduled time, you must wait until the last group has performed or a time opens up. Please note: Overnight groups will receive preferred performance times.

EQUIPMENT:

We provide music stands, chairs, piano, 1 bass Drum, and 2 timpani (24 & 26). Choral Risers are usually provided. Many sites have additional equipment available, please check with your local site director. We cannot be held responsible for providing storage for equipment.

ADJUDICATION:

You provide two conductor's scores for each of your performing group's. Scores should be labeled with the school name, director's name and performing group's name and be in an envelope. **Taped comments will now be done electronically, and you will receive the Mp3 comments via email after the site director returns to the office.**

DRESS:

Uniforms are not required. Informal dress is encouraged! Students and directors should wear casual clothes that are comfortable. Clothes that will enable them to relax and enjoy the fun-filled, action packed day. Facilities for changing clothes **will not** be provided. Please do not bring Hats, most rides do not allow hats.

WEATHER:

Amusement Parks are open rain or shine. Therefore, the festival will not be postponed or cancelled due to the weather.

FESTIVAL ETIQUETTE:

Please take a moment of rehearsal time to remind your students that they are NOT to wander in and out of the performance area, especially during the adjudication of another group.

AWARDS:

An award plaque with your rating will be presented at the conclusion of each performance, along with the adjudication forms.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Theme Park tickets will be picked up from the site director when you arrive at the festival.
